Quick facts about the project

Drawing on two voter-approved bond measures, Metro has protected four properties in this area on behalf of the region: Burlington Creek, Ennis Creek, McCarthy Creek, and North Abbey Creek. Totaling over 1,300 acres of forest habitat, together these sites are known as the North Tualatin Mountains.

In 2013, voters across the region approved a levy that allows Metro to restore the North Tualatin Mountains habitat and improve the experience for visitors. Tonight's event is the first of four meetings where public input will help guide Metro's investments on these properties.
