1:30 p.m.	Bluetooth Transition Planning <i>Bluetooth technology is a recommended detector in the regional TSMO arterial performance guide, going back to 2013. From the original pilot of Bluetooth on Powell Boulevard, our region's public and private partners led deployment of this low-cost tool to improve travel time for traffic and transit. Kittelson and Associates grew BlueMAC Analytics into private venture to support many agencies in the region but has made the tough decision to cease operations. Yi-Min Ha will share the transition plan and options for current BlueMAC subscribers. Agencies using Bluetooth will share their considerations for making a transition. All agencies deploying or utilizing travel time data are encouraged to join the discussion.
