Subject: Preliminary Analysis of Corridor Exercise

On April 3<sup>rd</sup>, the co-chairs asked Transportation Funding Task Force members to individually identify potential corridors for hypothetical 15 corridor and five corridor "investment measures," based on the Task Force values and their own personal experience. The purpose of the exercise was to provide a starting point for the next four weeks of conversation among Task Force members about how to ensure the corridor tiering recommendation you will advance to Metro Council at the end of May has the potential to meet the values and outcomes you and Metro Council have identified.

The preliminary results of that exercise are below. On this matrix, the left hand column lists the corridors that were selected by more than 20% of Task Force members (above 20%) when Task Force members were asked what corridors they would include in a 15 corridor measure. The middle column lists the corridors that were selected by more than 10% of Task Force members when asked about what corridors they would include in a five corridor measure. The right hand column, combines both scores in an attempt to demonstrate both the breadth and depth of interest in a certain corridor.

In response to Task Force member feedback, several segmented corridors have been combined into more recognizable corridors. This will be further described at the meeting on April  $24^{th}$ .
